### **Structured Work Place Learning On-the-Job Training:**

#### **VCE Unit status:**

- On completion of Certificate II in Creative Industries are eligible for up to three VCE VET units at Units 1 & 2 level (Program 1) and up to four VCE VET units – two at Units 1 & 2 and two units at Units 3 & 4 on their statement of results (Program 2).

#### **VCAL Unit Status:**

- When a student has been assessed as competent in units of competence totaling 100 nominal hours, this will contribute one VCAL unit towards satisfactory completion of the VCAL.

#### **ENTER Contribution:**

The contribution of the VCE VET in Creative Industries:

- Students wishing to receive an ENTER contribution for the Units 3 and 4 sequence VCE VET Multimedia must undertake scored assessment for the purpose of achieving a study score. This study score can contribute directly to the primary four or as a fifth or sixth study.
