

Funding Levels

VCAA endorsed VCE VET programs and VET certificates that are eligible for 'block credit' will be allocated a **funding level** depending on the relative cost of training delivery. Details of the levels are located at:

School funding allocations are based on the number of enrolments in these levels. Enrolments in an eligible VET course of a minimum of **180 hours** of training per year will attract the full level funding amount. Enrolments that have less than 180 hours per year will be funded on a **pro rata basis**.

The **indicative** levels that will apply in 2010 to the first two VET in Schools payments will be as follows:

- **Level 1 – \$966 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 2 – \$862 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 3 – \$785 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 4 – \$741 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 5 – \$669 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 6 – \$397 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 7 – \$324 per certificate enrolment**
- **Level 8 – \$289 per certificate enrolment**

These indicative level amounts will be adjusted in Term 3 and 4 payments, following confirmation of the VET in Schools enrolments on 28 April 2010.
